Take any action that limits CAB's ability to advocate on behalf of our mission;

Advocate for any measure that does not promote and/or demonstrate current "best practices" for cleaner air.

CAB Policy on Funding

CAB will accept:

Donations or grants consistent with fulfilling its mission: to monitor air quality, to educate the public on air quality, and to implement measures to alleviate poor air quality.

CAB will not accept:

Donations or grants conditioned on support of specific products or project development proposals.
