January 28–February 2, 2008



Focus the Nation is a national teach-in that will inspire dialogue at over a thousand colleges, universities and other organizations, directly engaging millions of students and citizens with the nation's decision-makers. The programs will culminate on January 31, 2008 in simultaneous educational symposia held across the country. The goal of this initiative is to move America beyond fatalism to a determination to face up to the challenge of climate change, the challenge of our generation.
